"Art Deco has been experiencing a revival over the past few years. As a bold and luxurious décor style, it can feel intimidating since it feels so glamorous. But don't worry — the latest version brings classic Art Deco elements and approachable contemporary style together.

Art Deco is known for its clean, geometric lines and motifs. However, with this contemporary update, curves and circular shapes soften the sharp lines. The great thing is you can introduce them to all parts of your home, whether as subtle accents or as big statements. This can be a round coffee table in the living room or scallop-shaped wallpaper for a feature wall.

Arches are one way of introducing curved motifs to the home. This could be arched doorways or transforming an alcove into an arch for a big impact. For a more subtle approach, choose a dining table or coffee table with round corners or a round rug to break up the straight lines of a room.

In this update, Art Deco takes inspiration from mid-century décor. While they may seem different at first, they have a few similarities. The new and improved Art Deco has retro influences with a muted colour palette and more emphasis on understated design. Herringbone flooring is a grounding way to bring these two influences together with calming texture and geometric design. Marrying luxe upholstery like velvet with the contemporary lines (or curves) of a retro-style sofa highlights the best of both styles.

How does this modern Art Deco stay true to its roots? Making a bold statement through luxe materials and statement furniture is key. A marble dining set in the dining room with statement lighting sets the scene for a stylish focal point and creates a glamorous Art Deco vibe. This can also be done in the living room with a jewel-toned velvet sofa and metallic accessories. Just like confidence, it's a style that isn't afraid to be seen."
